

Jeremiah

Jeremiah was one of the priests from what town in Israel? Jer 1:1 (See map)

Jeremiah prophesied from the reigns of what king and which of his sons? Jer 1:2-3

When Jeremiah first received a message from God, what excuse did he offer? Jer 1:6

How did God answer his excuse? Jer 1:7-10

Jeremiah was given a message to take to the people of Jerusalem. What was the message:

-Jer 1:14 =>

- Jer 4:3-4 =>

Jeremiah was prophesying to Judah, the Southern kingdom. He tells them to consider what happened to their northern neighbor Israel. How was Israel described? Jer 2:26-27

But instead of learning from what happened to Israel (the exile to Assyria), what is said about Judah? Jer 3: 8-10

Jer 4:16-18

Jeremiah goes to the temple in Jerusalem with what message? Jer 7:3-7

Jeremiah is given another message for the people. What was this? Jer 11:2-4

What was the reaction of those in Jeremiah's hometown to his warnings? Jer 11:21

What does God say he would do to those men? Jer 11:22-23

Jeremiah was told to go buy a new linen cloth, wear it, and then go hide it in the rocks near the Euphrates River. After a while he was told to go and get it, but it was ruined. What was the message for Jeremiah? Jer 13:9-10, 13-14

The Lord instructs Jeremiah not to do something anymore. What was he not to do? Jer 14:11-12

What did God say about the other 'prophets' who did not share Jeremiah's message? Jer 14:14-15

What king's actions started the decline in Judah? Jer 15:4

Because of what was going to happen, what was Jeremiah told not to do and why? Jer 16:2-5

What else were the people of Judah doing that offended God? Jer 17:22-23, 27

Jeremiah was sent to the potter's house to watch him remake a flawed pot. What message was Jeremiah to give from this? Jer 18:5-10

When the chief temple priest heard what Jeremiah was preaching, what did he do to him? Jer 20:1-2

What did Jeremiah say would happen to this man because of this? Jer 20:6

When Babylon comes against Jerusalem during the reign of King Zedekiah, men are sent to Jeremiah to ask him to ask God for a miracle to save them. What message did Jeremiah send back? Jer 21:3-9

Jeremiah prophesied about the coming messiah who would make things right again. What is said about him in Jer 23:5-6?

At one point, Jeremiah saw a vision of two baskets of figs. One was full of good figs, while the other was full of rotten figs. What was the message to Jeremiah?
Jer 24:5-7, 8-10

Jeremiah's message concerning Babylon was what? Jer 25: 8-9, 11, 12

Throughout the time Jeremiah prophesied, the people were conflicted about his words. Some recognized that he spoke the words of the Lord, and others rejected him and wanted to kill him. What was Jeremiah's response to his critics? Jer 26: 14-15

Jeremiah was instructed to fasten a yoke on his neck and deliver what message to the king of Judah? Jer 27:8, 12-14

One of Jeremiah's main adversaries was a 'prophet' named Hananiah from Gibeon. What did Jeremiah say would happen to him because of his opposition to God's Word?
Jer 28:15-17

Jeremiah wrote a letter to those who had previously been exiled to Babylon to encourage them. What did he tell them would happen? Jer 29:10-14

To emphasize God's promise to bring his people back after being exiled, what does God then instruct Jeremiah to do even while the city of Jerusalem itself was under siege? Jer 32:6-12, 15

When the Babylonians temporarily withdraw from the siege of Jerusalem due to the appearance of the Egyptian army in the South, King Zedekiah took back his promise to free all Hebrew slaves in the city. Because of this, what did God say through Jeremiah would happen? Jer 34:21-22 also see Jer 37:6-8

Jeremiah had his scribe, Baruch, write down all the prophecies on a scroll. As the scroll was read to the king, what did he order to be done? Jer 36: 22-24

Jeremiah was flogged and imprisoned in a dungeon cell and then later in the courtyard of the palace because of his prophecies, but Jeremiah kept preaching the same message. What happened to him then? Jer 38:6

What did a court official named Ebed-melech do to help Jeremiah? Jer 38:10-13

As the siege of Jerusalem continued, the king calls for Jeremiah to be brought to the temple and asks him what will happen. What did Jeremiah tell him? Jer 38:17-23

Because the king would not listen to Jeremiah, what happened when the Babylonians did break into the city and the king and his court tried to flee? Jer 39:4-6

When Jeremiah was found among the captives being taken to Babylon, what did the captain of the Babylonian guard do for Jeremiah? Jer 40:4-6

Against the word of the Lord, those left behind in Jerusalem begin worshipping idols and decided to go to Egypt to try to escape Babylonian control. Jeremiah tells them it will not work and what was their response? Jer 44:15-18

Jeremiah then prophesies the fall of the nations of Egypt, Philistia, Moab, Ammon, Syria (Damascus), Hazor, Kedar, and Elam by the Babylonians. Finally he prophesies the fall of Babylon itself. How complete will the destruction of Babylon be? Jer 51:62
