## What Will Jesus Coming Be Like

Since we live according to the natural laws that God has established, it is difficult for us to imagine an event that is totally outside the scope of our natural environment. Just as people in Noah's day rejected the idea of a flood that would destroy all and change the earth forever, people today reject the second coming of Jesus and the final destruction of the earth by fire. But the scriptures are clear that this is indeed the case.

Read **2Peter 3:3-10**, and tell:

Why has the Lord not returned yet?

What will happen to the heavens and the earth on the 'day of the Lord'?

On this great Day, Jesus will return. Read the following scriptures and answer:

Read **1Thess 4:16** – Will Jesus come symbolically or personally?

Read **Acts 1:9-11** – In what way will Jesus return?

Read **2Thess 1:7** – From where will Jesus come?

Read **Heb 10:12-13** – We are told to wait for Jesus to come. For what is Jesus waiting?

The second coming of Jesus will be a very noisy time. Read **1Thess 4:16**, and tell three audible elements that will mark his coming:

The term "command" or "shout" carries the idea of a military command. While we do not know for sure what will be shouted consider the following scriptures as possibilities. Read each and tell what significance that 'shout' might have for the second coming:

**Luke 9:35 =>**

**John 11:43 =>**

**Rev 10:1-6 =>**

No matter what is shouted, there will be no doubt what is happening when it occurs! The scriptures also point out that Jesus will not be coming alone. Read the following and tell:

Read **Matt 16:27** – Who will come with Jesus when He returns?

What is the stated purpose of His return in this scripture?

Read **Matt 25:31** – What will Jesus do when He comes in His glory?

Read **2Thess 1:7-9** – Besides angels, what else involved in Jesus coming?

On whom will Jesus take vengeance?

What is the role of the mighty powerful angels in this vengeance?

(See **Matt 13:41-42**)

Many have questions about those who have died before Jesus returns.

Read **1Thess 4:14** – How does Paul reassure those who fear for the well-being of their loved ones who have died?

Read **1Thess 3:13** – Who does this scripture say Jesus will bring with Him?

Read **Rev 6:9-11** – What does this imply will occur at the second coming?

Other considerations are found in these scriptures:

Read **1Cor 15:51-53**, and tell what will happen when the trumpet of God sounds:

Read **1Pet 4:13 and 2Thess 1:10**, and tell the reaction of the Christian to Jesus' coming:

Read **Col 3:4 and Rom 8:17**, and tell what awaits the Christians on that great Day:

Read **Heb 2:10-12**, and tell what our relationship with Christ will be on that Day:
