QUESTION OF THE WEEK

How old was Jesus and where was he when the 'wise men' came to bring their gifts?

- Angels were present at the creation of the earth. Job 38: 4-7

-Angels are not Divine, but are created by Christ. Col 1:16 "For by him (Christ) all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him."

- Angels were created with freewill. 2 Peter 2:4-5 "For if God did not spare angels when they sinned, but sent them to Hades (Tartarus), putting them into gloomy dungeons to be held for judgment;

- The number of angels is beyond counting. Heb 12:22 "But you have come to Mount Zion, to the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God. You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly" Rev 5:11 "Then I looked and heard the voice of many angels, numbering thousands upon thousands, and ten thousand times ten thousand."

- Only two angels are named in the Bible – Michael the Archangel (Jude 9, Daniel 10:13) and Gabriel who stands in the presence of God (Luke 1:19). Jewish Apocryphal books mention two others – Raphael and Uriel.

- The Bible mentions two classes of angels – Seraphim and Cherubim. The Seraphim are described as having a face, hands, feet, and six wings. (Isa 6:1-6) and the Cherubim are described as having four faces, hands, four wings that made a lot of noise, and being covered with eyes. (Ezek 10: 1-21, Exodus 37:9)

- Angels are ministering spirits for the saved. Heb 1:14 "Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?"

- Angels are interested in the salvation plans God has made. 1 Pet 1:10-12 and Luke 15:10 "In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents."

- Angels can appear on earth as men. They appeared to Abraham when he was living under the oak at Mamre (Gen 18:1-5, 19:1-3) and to the wife of Manoah about the birth of Samson (Judges 13:3-9) and even the Hebrew writer says: Heb 13:2 "Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some people have entertained angels without knowing it."

- Angels have been involved in helping men. An angel fed Elijah when he was fleeing Jezebel (1 Kings 19:5-6), protected Daniel from the lions (Dan 6:22), saved Hezekiah from the Assyrians (Isa 37:36), freed Peter from prison (Acts 12:7-10), and carried Lazarus to Abraham's bosom. (Luke 16:22)
