QUESTION OF THE WEEK

On what creation day was the sun,
moon, and stars created?

- Angels may not always be visible when they help. Elisha had to pray to have his servant 'see' the angels of the Lord surrounding the enemies around the city of Dothan. 2 Kings 6:13-17 The king sent horses and chariots and a strong force there. They went by night and surrounded the city. When the servant of the man of God got up and went out early the next morning, an army with horses and chariots had surrounded the city. "Oh, my lord, what shall we do?" the servant asked. "Don't be afraid," the prophet answered. "Those who are with us are more than those who are with them." And Elisha prayed, "O LORD, open his eyes so he may see." Then the LORD opened the servant's eyes, and he looked and saw the hills full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

- Angels are sometimes involved in bringing men to Christ. An angel told Philip to go meet the Ethiopian eunuch. (Acts 8:25-28) and in telling Cornelius to sent to Joppa to get Peter (Acts 10:6) Note that angels did not 'save' anyone, they just directed others to those seeking salvation.

- Angels were involved with Christ throughout his life, death, and resurrection. Angels announced His birth (Luke 2:9-13), ministered to him after the wilderness temptations (Matt 4:11), strengthened him when he prayed in Gethsemane (Luke 22:43), rolled back the stone at his tomb (Matt 28:2), announced his resurrection (Luke 24:4-6), and said that Jesus would come back as he had ascended (Acts 1:11)

- Jews believed that every one of God's people (the saved) had a 'guardian angel'. Matt 18:10 "See that you do not look down on one of these little ones. For I tell you that their angels in heaven always see the face of my Father in heaven." Also see Acts 12:12-15.

- Angels will accompany Jesus when he returns. Matt 25:31 "When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, he will sit on his throne in heavenly glory." 2 Thess 1:7-8 "... and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus."

- The Archangel will announce Jesus coming. 1 Thess 4:16 "For the Lord himself will come down from heaven, with a loud command, with the voice of the archangel and with the trumpet call of God, and the dead in Christ will rise first."

- Angels will assist in separating the righteous from the wicked. Matt 13:41-43 "The Son of Man will send out his angels, and they will weed out of his kingdom everything that causes sin and all who do evil. They will throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth. Then the righteous will shine like the sun in the kingdom of their Father. He who has ears, let him hear.

Matt 13:49-50 "This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth."
