QUESTION OF THE WEEK

How old was Joseph when he was sold by his brothers as a slave?

Scientists studying the human condition tell us that to survive, humans need seven basic things not only to survive, but to thrive. These are air, water, food, light, clothing, shelter, and companionship. The Bible points out that our God supplies all of these things for us through His Son, Jesus. The Lord has given us all that we need in Him. For example:

Air – We need air to breathe, it must have the correct amount of oxygen to sustain life and be continually available. The Bible tells us that it was God who gave us the air that sustains life and enables us to breathe it. Genesis 2:7

Then the Lord God formed a man from the dust of the ground and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life and man became a living soul. And Paul told the Athenians— Acts 17:25 And he is not served by human hands, as if he needed anything. Rather, he himself gives everyone life and breath and everything else.

Water – We need a continuing supply of water to replenish our bodies. The Bible tells us that Jesus can give us an inexhaustible supply—John 4:14

“but whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” And Paul also reminded the Athenians that even the rain continues to come from God -Acts 14:17 “Yet he has not left himself without testimony: He has shown kindness by giving you rain from heaven”

Food – We need food to supply the nourishment that our bodies need. In the Old Testament, God provided food for the wandering Israelites by sending them manna (food from heaven) every day. (John 6:31) Jesus said in John 6:51 “I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats this bread will live forever.” And Paul told the Athenians—Acts 14:17 “He has shown kindness by giving you ...crops in their seasons; he provides you with plenty of food and fills your hearts with joy.”

Light – Light is needed to allow us to see things as they are, as well as to form necessary compounds in our skin. God not only made the light (Gen 1:3), but He IS light (1John 1:5). The Bible tells us that Jesus is the light we need in this world John 8:12 “When Jesus spoke again to the people, he said, “I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life.” And Paul points out the purpose of light in Ephesians 5:13 “But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light.”

Clothing – Our bodies need protection from the things around us and to cover our nakedness. God provided clothes for man when Adam and Eve first realized this, (Gen 3:21). The Bible tells us that He has also provided a covering for us in his son, Jesus—Galatians 3:27 “for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ.” This provides us with protection for our bodies from the evils around us – Gal 6:10-18.

Shelter – We also need protection from the elements, a place where we can feel safe and secure. Our Lord also provides this for us—Psalm 62:6 “Truly he is my rock and my salvation; he is my fortress, I will not be shaken.” Jesus prayed for his disciples to be protected while in this world—John 17:15 “My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one.”

Companionship- From the very beginning, God knew that it was not good for the man to be alone (Gen 2:18). Our Lord has promised that we will never be alone because He will never leave us—Hebrews 13:5 “Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have, because God has said, “Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you.” And Jesus has told us—Matthew 28:20 “And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”

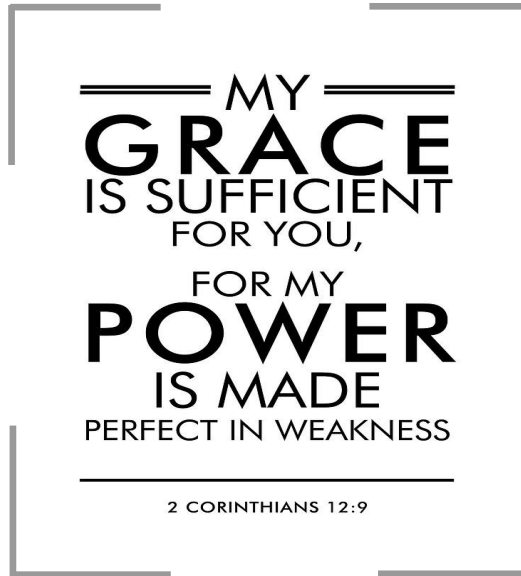
