- They say that she used to be nice.

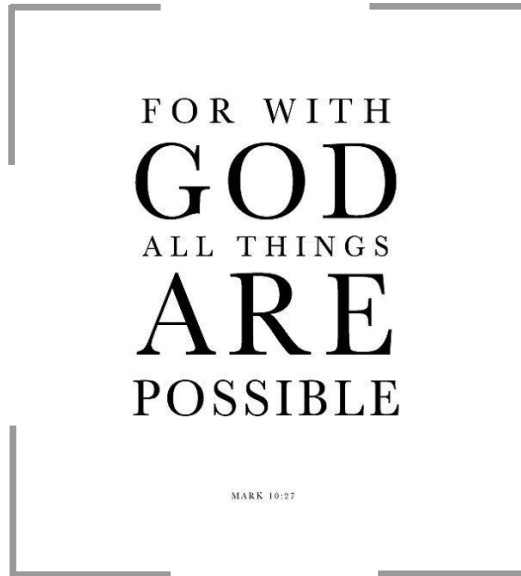
