angels of God.

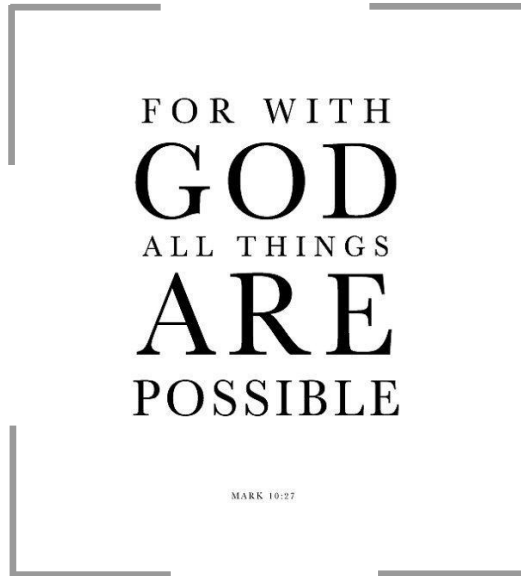
Matthew 10:40 "Anyone who welcomes you welcomes me, and anyone
