QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Who was the king that allowed the Jews to return home after the Babylonian captivity?

When a person is trying to live the Christian life, they can become stressed and worn- out by the constant pull of this world trying to force them to compromise and accept society's standards. To help us in this fight, the Lord has given us the avenue of prayer... Do you recognize any of these signs of spiritual fatigue in your life?

-When you pray, it is only about you and what you want.

-You avoid opportunities to get together with other Christians because "God talk" makes you feel uncomfortable

-You cannot find the scriptures for 'what you believe'.

-You are too busy and unwilling to sacrifice anything of 'yours' – time, talent, resources – to serve God or others.

-You have a casual attitude toward worship and are habitually late or absent. You are the last one in to services and the first one out.

-Your view of 'what the church is to do and be' has become worldly and denominational. The church is considered no different from any other group.

-You refuse to take responsibility for your actions. It is always someone else's fault

-You cannot think of anything that you can do to promote the gospel.

-Sports, jobs, school, and friends come before Christ, especially before Bible study on Sunday and Wednesday night.

-You deny the reality of sin and its eternal consequences in your life. Death and judgment seem far away or irrelevant to your life now.

If you recognize yourself in any of these things, you can find help in prayer. One of the things that can wear a Christian down is the strain of worry and concern for your children. We need to pray for each other, especially for help in difficult family situations. Pray for the parents of adult children who have fallen away will have the wisdom to know the right things to say to influence those children to return to the church. Pray that the parents will keep a strong faith and never accept unfaithfulness as 'inevitable'. Pray that they may see their need and error and repent. Pray for faithfulness in this time of hard economic uncertainty. It is so easy to fall away when just 'getting by' is difficult. It is easy to fall out of the habit of attending – pray for learning God's word and strengthening each other at every opportunity. Pray for the strength to overcome your spiritual fatigue and regain your joy and zeal for the Lord and His Word.
