QUESTION OF THE WEEK

Who were Timothy's mother and grandmother?

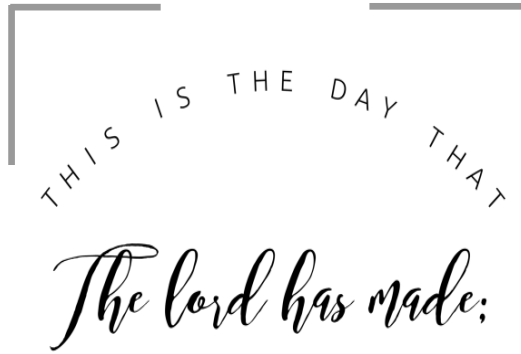
Did you know that the idea of evolution did not begin with Charles Darwin and his book 'Origin of species' in 1859. The ideas he presented had been kicked around by those who opposed God for a long time before him. Did you know that Charles' own grandfather, Erasmus Darwin wrote a paper called Zoonomia in 1794 promoting these concepts. What Charles did was popularized the idea that evolution could occur through a series of small changes to produce entirely different creatures with new forms and functions. While this has been shown to be false over and over again, this idea is still promoted with natural selection combined with genetic mutations being the evolutionists explanation as to how things came about. When Darwin wrote his book, most people were church-goers and the popularity of traveling circuses was growing as a form of entertainment. One circus, the Barnum and Bailey, had featured diseased, deformed, and other individuals – promoting them as “the wild man of the prairies’, The Lobster man, the mule-faced woman, the Dog faced man, spider woman, Hopp the frog boy, the lion faced man, Camel girl, wolf man, or ‘ Tom Thumb’ - but when Darwin came out with his book – they saw an opportunity to promote their bottom line by promoting a ‘monkey man’ as something looking human but with the anatomy of an orangutan which they said was the ‘missing link’. They advertised that this ‘savage’ creature was a ‘man-monkey’ captured while swinging from the trees in an African jungle who had been examined by the most ‘scientific’ men and identified as the connecting link between men and apes. They gave him the name ‘zip’ – and asked “is it an animal? Is it human? Or is it the long awaited link hitherto undiscovered.

Zip, it turns out was man born in New Jersey named William Henry Johnson. He had a form of dwarfism and mentally disabled with a small head and a tapering cranium and large jaw. His parents, needing money offered him to a circus as an ‘oddity’, and a ‘missing link’ – but Barnum and Bailey saw it as money making opportunity. He was given a new look – a furry suit to wear and a shaved head with just a tuft of hair on top to accent his sloping brow. He was told to rattle the bars of a cage and screech. He was told to walk with a stick and bent over. He loved the attention and followed the instructions given him for years. As he aged, he was promoted as ‘becoming civilized’ and continued to entertain in the circus for 67 years.

It was the promotion of evolution that caused people with physical problems to be promoted in this way. Even today, some elites in our society look on others as not as ‘evolved’ as they are and try to force their opinions and actions on others. They reject God and follow their own ideas in a continual quest for power. May we as Christians understand that there is only one creator who made one race – the human race and sent his son to bring salvation to all who will accept and follow him.
