When a person is trying to live the Christian life, they can become stressed and worn- out by the constant pull of this world trying to force them to compromise and accept society's standards instead of remaining true to the word of the Lord. To help us in this fight, the Lord has given us the avenue of prayer. But many have become so fatigued by the daily struggles that their prayers are not what they should be and so they struggle as they try to live under their own power. Do you recognize any of these signs of spiritual fatigue in your life?

- When you pray, it is only about you and what you want.
- You avoid opportunities to get together with other Christians.
- You cannot find the scriptures for 'what you believe'.
- You are unwilling to sacrifice anything of 'yours' – time, talent, resources – to serve God or others.
- You have a casual attitude toward worship and are habitually late or absent.
- Your view of 'what the church is to do and be' has become worldly and denominational.
- You refuse to take responsibility for your actions.
- You cannot think of anything that you can do to promote the gospel.
- Sports, jobs, school, and friends come before Christ.
- You deny the reality of sin and its eternal consequences in your life.

If you recognize yourself in any of these things, you can find help in prayer – both your own and those of others for you. One of the things that can wear a Christian down is the strain of worry and concern for your children. We need to be aware of power of prayer to help in difficult family situations. We need to pray for each other, especially for these things: Pray for the parents of adult children who have fallen away from the Lord. Pray that the parents will have the wisdom to know the right things to say to influence those children to return to the church. Pray that the parents will keep a strong faith and never give up on their children or accept their unfaithfulness as 'inevitable'. Pray that the Lord will bring something into the lives of the unfaithful so that they may see their need and error and repent. Pray that each of us may be a strong example of faith for them to follow. It is so easy to fall away when just 'getting by' is difficult, and work demands that we miss services. Pray for the strength to overcome your spiritual fatigue and regain your joy and zeal for the Lord and His Word.
