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QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What Old Testament book begins
with the letter 'O'?

Knowing What was Needed

A man owned a gas meter repair company and had clients from small cities and towns that contracted to have meters repaired and refurbished. He also got some calls from a few industrial plants. One day he received a call for emergency service from a large company where a mal-functioning meter caused a main line production to shut down. He drove 200 miles one way to answer their cry for help. Upon arrival, he recognized the particular brand and model of meter and knew that a common problem was a stuck meter valve. With a rubber mallet, he gently struck the meter in the appropriate place and the meter began to function again. In less than 30 minutes the line was back in full production again. He made arrangements to return and install a new meter when the plant was shut down later in the week, and he presented his bill for \$600 for the emergency call. It was received with skepticism and he was asked to submit an itemized bill to justify the price for only thirty minutes work. When he rewrote the bill it said:

Striking defective meter to free sticking valve - \$50

Knowing where and with what force to strike meter - \$550

Total - \$600

Do we ever do a similar thing to Jesus? The cry of sin was heard in heaven and the answer was to send Jesus Christ. He alone was sinless and had the ability to save us, and yet people question the terms he laid down for their salvation. He supplied an 'itemized bill' in a sense:

He said that we must believe in Him as God's Son — John 8:24 "I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am the one I claim to be, you will indeed die in your sins."

And Jesus said — Luke 13:3 *"I tell you, no! But unless you repent, you too will all perish"*

And Jesus also said — Matt 10:32 *"Whoever acknowledges me before men, I will also acknowledge him before my Father in heaven."*

And he said — Mark 16:16 *"Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned."*

He knew exactly what we needed and what he had to do to make the forgiveness of our sins possible. He was willing to do what was needed for each of us. What right do we have to question what he said or try to find another way. Let us simply believe it, teach it, and follow it. He knows what is needed.
