## Who to Support

We are told in Romans 13:1-7 that we are to respect and obey the government authorities. But this is not to be blind obedience if their laws or decrees violate the word of God - Acts 5:29. It seems as though our government has grown to the point where it wants to take over every aspect of our lives. What should we, as Christians who desire to follow the Word of God and citizens of this nation, do when selecting those to support with our vote and assistance look for in a candidate? The following are some suggestions for which we have Biblical backing or examples - as well as others endorsed in the writings of the founding fathers of our country:

1) We need to hold our elected officials accountable both morally and ethically for their actions. We cannot 'overlook' failures because they are 'politicians'. And when they fail, they must be removed from office. We are all responsible for our actions - Romans 14:12

2) We should support those who encourage all able bodied people to work and help those who cannot. Eph 4:29, 2 Thess 3:10 This would require that their policies support an environment where private businesses can grow and create jobs, not a government that imposes more and more regulations. The needs of those who cannot work should be taken care of by the 'churches' and private organizations, not locking them into endless programs through the federal government.

3) Our government should have no say in running other countries or having them run our country. (as the UN tries to do). Our business is to take care of our own situation - 1Cor 5:12 Likewise, disasters in other countries should be dealt with by private and corporate groups who can make sure the supplies get where they are needed. (Not just sending money which so often end up lining the pockets of foreign heads of state).

4) We need to support those who see the job of government is to protect the citizens without encroaching on their lives and liberties, or making laws which would attempt to force them to violate their religious beliefs. 1Tim 2:1-2

What the crux of the matter is that the government must be reduced in its power and control of people's lives and that power to govern returned to the states as the founding fathers intended.
