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QUESTION OF THE WEEK

What king issued the decree that the Jews could return to their homeland from the exile?

The most important question that anyone can ever ask is "What must I do to be saved?" But asking that question is only one part of seeking to be right with the Lord. There are several questions that one must ask themselves if they are to honestly evaluate their situation in life.

If we are to find the answers that we seek in trying to be right with the Lord, we must also consider these other related questions:

- Am I trying to please God, or someone else? Our ultimate goal must be to please God (Acts 5:29, 2Cor 5:9) Do we know what we ought to do, but fail to do it due to pressure from others? (John 12:42)
- Am I trying to hide my sins? God knows everything about us (Ps 139:7-16). Until we are ready to lay everything at his feet, ready to give up all aspects of our lives, we are not ready to seek the salvation that he offers.
- Am I looking for the wrong type of rewards? Am I motivated by physical things, the here and now, or is your mind and trust centered on the spiritual rewards in heaven? (Matt 6:19-21) This was the problem with the rich young ruler.
- Am I afraid of what people might say or how they might react? (Matthew 10:28) The only one we are to fear is the Lord Himself – He is the one who controls eternity.
- Am I being honest with myself and with God? Jesus told the parable of the soils in Luke 8:4-15. There are different types of hearts onto which the word of God falls. It is only the heart that is prepared to receive the seed that will bring forth salvation. What kind of soil is in our heart? Are we ready to take in the word and let it grow and consume our life?

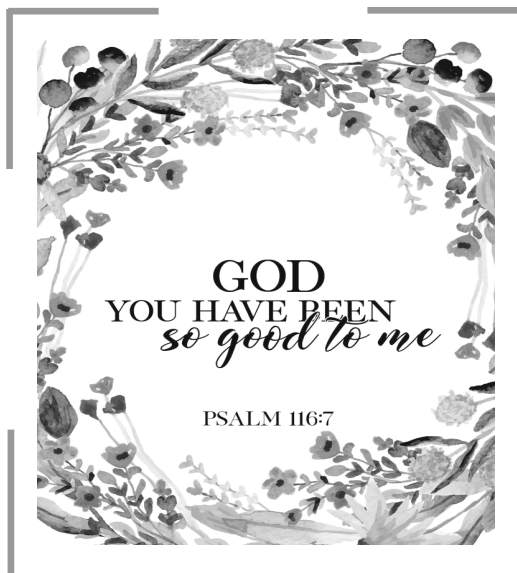
