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QUESTION OF THE WEEK

In what Bible books are all the
kings of Judah and Israel listed?

Philippians 4:4-9 *Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near. Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me—put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you.*

In these verses we find the secret for living in the peace of God. There are six things for one to do who is seeking to find the life of peace as God's child. They include:

- Be in the Lord (vs 4). If we are to rejoice 'in the Lord', then we must be in Him. This is done through baptism - Gal 3:27, Mark 16:16. One cannot live at peace with God if they have not obeyed the gospel - those who have not will be punished and shut out from the Lord (2Thess 1:8-9). Being in Christ gives us reason to rejoice and have peace in our souls.
- Show gentleness to everyone. This includes those who insult us and our loved ones or falsely accuse us. It includes those who live selfishly and ignore the needs of others. We must cultivate the forgiving spirit that is necessary for the child of God. **Matthew 6:14-15** *"For if you forgive other people when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive others their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins."* and in Romans 12:17 *"Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone."*
- Remember that the Lord is near. Keep in mind that the Lord gave us the Holy Spirit to live in us and that we are the temple of the Lord. 1 Corinthians 6:19 *"God is with us everyday and everywhere."* We are never alone and that fact gives us peace and comfort.
- Don't be anxious, instead pray about everything big and small. The Lord is concerned with every aspect of your life and He takes away anxiety when we trust Him and put our concerns in His hands. 1 Peter 5:7 *"Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you."* Give thanks to Him for this blessed assurance.
- Fill your mind with thoughts that are pure, right, and worthy of a godliness. Be so busy thinking right and doing right that there is no time or room for anything but the Lord's peace and contentment in your life.

When we fill our lives with gentleness, forgiveness, sensing the presence of the Lord with us - we will find the peace that is beyond all understanding. When we put all our concerns in God's hands through prayer and fill our hearts and minds with the goodness of His Word, then we will have the contentment we seek no matter what the circumstances in our lives.
