A SHEEP, NOT A LAMB

We know the parable of the lost sheep that Jesus told in Luke 15:3-7:

Then Jesus told them this parable: 4 “Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn’t he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? 5 And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders 6 and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, ‘Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.’ 7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

Did you realize that it was a full grown sheep that left the company of the ninety-nine and went astray – it was not a lamb ! It was a full grown sheep that the shepherd sought and brought back rejoicing. Why did Jesus choose to make it a sheep instead of a lamb? Jesus knew the danger – if the sheep go astray, the lambs will follow. If a sheep goes wrong, the lambs are right behind. The lesson is not just that God is concerned with the individual, but with the power of influence that the individual has on those around them. There are many full grown sheep who have strayed away from the Shepherd and His Word. Their lambs are following them into the same error and eventual destruction. We need to pray for and try to restore the sheep, not only for their sake, but also for the sake of their lambs. If the lambs are lost, some sheep will have a terrible price to pay at judgment.

How many children never become Christians because they see their parents lacking commitment to the church. When the parents prioritize recreation, sports, and school activities over Bible study and worship, the children get the message that Christianity is not all that important. Time passes and the parents wonder why their children are not interested 'in church' anymore.

Remember, the lambs will follow the sheep!
